- Host at least two DVC 101 trainings per year to community originations, hospitals, educational systems, and/or employers

- Review Annual Domestic Violence Report to the Community (Goal 1 & 2 | Executive Board)
- Host at least two "Service Provider Awareness" informational meetings per year with at least 15 attendees per meeting
- Updated and relevant protocols & best practices, informed by most current evidence based research & available on RMCDVC.org
- Generate & implement recommendations based on hypothesized explanations
